In fact, the majority of Old Testament quotations in the Greek New Testament were from the Greek Septuagint Old Testament, primarily from Psalms, Isaiah, Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Deuteronomy, and the Book of the Twelve. Very early, the New Testament books were recognized as inspired by God. Clement of Rome mentioned at least eight New Testament books by 95 AD, and Polycarp, a disciple of John, acknowledged 15 books of the New Testament by 108 AD.
