The IHSAA Officials Department oversees the licensing and testing of Illinois high school officials. Officials are licensed in 16 different sports: baseball, basketball, football, boys gymnastics, girls gymnastics, boys lacrosse, girls lacrosse, soccer, softball, swimming and diving, track and field, volleyball, water polo, wrestling, competitive cheerleading, and dance.

All officials must score 75 percent or higher on an online open-book exam in the sport (s) for which they intend to officiate. Exams may be retaken twice if necessary. All officials are required to view an online rules interpretation meeting pertaining to their sport (s) before the season begins. To become varsity eligible, new officials of football, basketball, baseball, and wrestling must attend a clinic within the first three years of registration.
